





Decade of Growth for SGB Intermediaries





50% of Capacity Development Providers founded in past decade*



85% of Investment Vehicles founded in past decade


Number of Investment Vehicles Launched






Fewer Funds, Larger Target Sizes






Continue to See Low Focus on Seed Stage






Easier to Raise Funds than to Deploy




Proportion of Committed Capital that Has Been Deployed







Investimento de Impacto no Brasil



22 investidores participaram do estudo

- 20 já realizando investimentos
- 2 planejando iniciar em 2014
- 12 internacionais
- 10 nacionais

Investimento de Impacto no Brasil



Tamanhao do mercado e investimentos

- Mercado local gerencia \$177 milhões em capital comprometido de 8 dos 9 investidores locais
- Investidores internacionais gerenciam aproximadamene **\$3 bilhões** em capital comprometido
- Desde o primeiro investimento em 2003, \$76.1 milhões já foram alocados em negócios de impacto no Brasil
- **68** negócios de impacto receberam investimentos
- \$90 milhões a \$127 milhões é o volume planejado de investimentos em 2014 por investidores nacionais e internacionais
